

ORDINANCE FOR ENFORCEMENT OF

LOWNDES COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH RULES AND REGULATIONS

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING A CODE OF ENFORCEMENT OF RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE LOWNDES COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH; EXPRESS ADOPTION OF APPLICABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS; DELEGATION OF DUTIES OF IMPLEMENTATION AND ENFORCEMENT TO LOWNDES COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH; PROVISION FOR CRIMINAL PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR PROVISION OF PROCEDURAL RIGHTS; ESTABLISHMENT OF JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF REMERTON MUNICIPAL COURT OVER VIOLATORS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

ALL FOR THE PROTECTION AND PRESERVATION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE OF THE PEOPLE OF REMERTON, GEORGIA.

I.

There are currently in existence certain rules and regulations adopted by the Lowndes County Board of Health with the purpose of preserving the public health, safety, and welfare of citizens of Lowndes County, Georgia. This ordinance specifically incorporates by reference the provision of the following rules and regulations which are in force at the time of the adoption of this ordinance and as amended:

- A. Rules and Regulations pertaining to Rabies control (adopted by the Lowndes County Board of Health and being Lowndes County Board of Health Rule II as subsequently amended and updated), and policies of the Lowndes County Board of Health pertaining to Rabies Control;

- B. Rules and Regulations for On-Site Sewage Management Systems (adopted by the Department of Public Health (Chapter 290-5-26-.01-.20) and the Lowndes County Board of Health and being Lowndes County Board of Health Rule III as subsequently amended and updated), and policies of the Lowndes County Board of Health pertaining to On-Site Sewage Management Systems;

- C. Rules and Regulation pertaining to Onsite Water Supplies (adopted by the Lowndes County Board of Health and being Lowndes County Board of Health Rule IV as subsequently amended and updated), and policies of the Lowndes County Board of Health pertaining to Onsite Water Supplies;
- D. Rules and Regulations pertaining to Food Service (adopted by the Department of Public Health (Chapter 290-5-14) and the Lowndes County Board of Health and being Lowndes County Board of Health Rule V as subsequently amended and updated), and policies of the Lowndes County Board of Health pertaining to Food Service;
- E. Rules and Regulations pertaining to Public Swimming Pools, Spas, and Natural Beaches (adopted by the Lowndes County Board of Health and being Lowndes County Board of Health Rule VI-C as subsequently amended and updated), and policies of the Lowndes County Board of Health pertaining to Public Swimming Pools, Spas, and Natural Beaches;
- F. Rules and Regulations pertaining to Tourist Accommodations (adopted by the Department of Public Health (Chapter 290-5-18) and the Lowndes County Board of Health and being Lowndes County Board of Health Rule VII as subsequently amended and updated), and policies of the Lowndes County Board of Health pertaining to Tourist Accommodations;
- G. Rules and Regulations pertaining to Body Art (adopted by the Lowndes County Board of Health and being rules and regulations for Body Art Studios and Artists as subsequently amended and updated), and policies of the Lowndes County Board of Health pertaining to Body Art; and

II.

The duty of implementation and enforcement of these regulations rest with the Remerton City Council and by virtue of this ordinance is hereby expressly delegated to the Lowndes County Board of Health who is hereby charged with promulgation of sufficient procedures for insuring compliance with these rules and regulations by the citizens of Remerton. The Lowndes County Board of Health is directed to implement

procedures which will insure that the citizens of Remerton will receive all procedural rights to which they are entitled under the laws of the State of Georgia.

III.

Any violation of the rules and regulations hereby referenced shall be a violation of this ordinance and shall be a misdemeanor offense. Any violator shall be subject to the imposition of a fine not to exceed \$1000.00 and/or imprisonment for a period not to exceed twelve (12) months. Any failure of payment of inspection fees listed within the fee schedule adopted by Lowndes County Board of Health, may result in suspension of permit.

IV.


The City of Remerton Municipal Court shall have jurisdiction over violators of this ordinance and all procedures for enforcement of such ordinance shall be as provided in the Official Code of Georgia. Complaints of violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be brought before the City of Remerton Municipal Court by a designated representative of Lowndes County Board of Health and shall be prosecuted through that court.

The effective date of this ordinance shall be 12/12/11. Passed in regular session of the Remerton City Council, on 12/12/11.
